Andrew Wong

Andrew is currently a member of A Cappella group "Boonfaysau". Sharing A Cappella music, the group has won the Champion of Taiwan Vocal Asia Festival 2018, VoiceJam Award 2018 from Walton Arts Center in Arkansas, Hong Kong Youth Association 2018 Champion of Hong Kong Open Category of Hong Kong International A Cappella Competition, and Champion of Macau Asia A Cappella Festival 2017.

With experience in composing, arranging, mixing and recording, Andrew is good at combining different elements of music to arrange Cantonese songs' mash-up and medley with A Cappella. Arranging songs for the Hong Kong Youth Association International A Cappella Music Festival and Cityplaza, he also designed the film soundtrack and theme song for the graduation work "On My Way" by the School of Film and Television of the Academy of Performing Arts in 2021, bringing a refreshing experience and enjoyment to the audience.

Kessay Chan

Kessay is an active A Cappella artist. He has won several local and international awards including "Top 10 Young Artist 2019" and Singapore A Cappella Championship Loopstation champions for 2 years in 2018 and 2019. He was invited to TEDx event to share his A Cappella experiences.

He received the "Multi Excellence Scholarship", a full tuition scholarship granted by Home Affairs Bureau, and graduated from Music Department of The Chinese University of Hong Kong. During his time in CUHK, he studied classical singing with his mentor Mr. Caleb Woo, and conducted research on A Cappella pedagogy for elderly. He also passed the Trinity ATCL Piano with distinction.

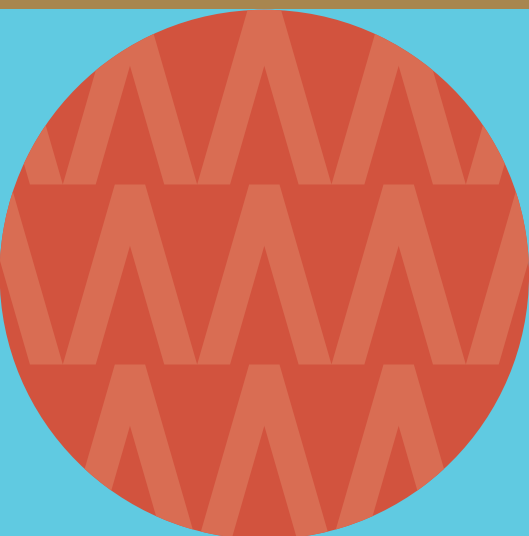
Kessay enjoys working on music production and education, as well as video production. He started "Wai Sing Music" in 2020, focusing on organizing A Cappella events and video production.

Winky Wong

Winky Wong is an A Cappella arranger as well as a performer. She graduated at the Chinese University of Hong Kong with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Music, majoring in voice under the tutelage of Mr. Caleb Woo. She is currently the Musician Intern of Yat Po Singers.

Winky was the Choir Captain in her alma mater, the Belliios Public School. She joined The Greeners' Sound, a young adult choir comprised in SATB setting, in 2016 and was the Choral Conductor in 2018-2019. The choir achieved Second Place at the 71st Hong Kong Schools Music Festival Senior (open) Mixed Category competition.

Winky is also a member of the Chan Fai Young x Women's Choir. Recent performances include The Girls' Prayer (2016), Girls in Tears (2018-2019) and People Come, People Go (2021). She also participated in two studio-recorded albums The Girls' Prayer and Girls in Tears. The Girls' Prayer was awarded the Best Collection Album in the 2017 Chinese Music Awards.
